Status of course/research progress

Over the course of 2 months since I've been in here, I have been performing experiments using DNA samples from several human populations. These include sequencing complete mitochondrial sequences using Next-Generation DNA Sequencing machines as well as genotyping genome-wide Single Nucleotide Polymorhisms (SNP). I expect to finish the labwork by the end of August and spend my remaining time here to analyze the data that I generated. I also had the opportunity to travel to Lyon, France for the SMBE meeting in early July where I presented a poster of my recent work.

Life situation

The people in Mark Stoneking's group and the supporting staff of the Max Planck Institute have been very helpful and accommodating. They helped me find a fully-furnished apartment not far from the institute and city center. There are several Chinese students at the institute but I have yet to meet any Japanese here. Even though I don't speak much German, language isn't a problem as most people here can speak some English.
