

Agreement and Terms of Use for Information Infrastructure and Services

At National University Corporation Institute of Science Tokyo, we offer various information services to support the study, research, and work of its students, faculty, and staff. In order to use the information infrastructure and services, we require the following agreements and consents. Please be informed of the following details.

1. Agreement and Consent for Use of Information Infrastructure and Services:
 - Comply with the relevant regulations of the Institute.
 - Adhere to the Science Tokyo Information Infrastructure Usage Guidelines (see reverse).
 - Understand that there are legal and social responsibilities associated with sending and receiving information and the use of information devices and software both inside and outside the Institute.
 - Refrain from actions that disrupt the stable operation of the information infrastructure or cause damage to third parties.
 - Acknowledge that in the case of improper use causing damage to the Institute or third parties, the individual responsible may bear the liability.
 - Consent to the Institute verifying personal communication logs and patterns if necessary for information security.
2. Consent for Providing Personal Information to Third Parties, etc. in the Use of Information Infrastructure and Services:
 - Acknowledge that personal information (such as email addresses and account names assigned by the Institute) will be shared with SaaS providers, etc. in the use of the Institute's information infrastructure and service.
 - Understand that personal information (such as names, affiliations, and email addresses assigned by the Institute) will be disclosed to users of the internal information infrastructure and services and to external partners.
 - Recognize that accounts for using the information infrastructure cannot be suspended during enrollment or employment except for valid reasons.
 - Accept that account information and interactions will be retained in the applications even after account expiration due to graduation, completion of studies, or retirement.
 - Understand that you are prohibited from using personal information obtained through the use of the information infrastructure in an unauthorized manner.

Science Tokyo Information Infrastructure Usage Guidelines

The use of the information infrastructure and services of National University Corporation Institute of Science Tokyo must not include any acts that violate applicable laws or regulations, or that are contrary to public order and morals. Furthermore, the following actions are prohibited unless approved according to the relevant regulations:

1. Using the Institute's information infrastructure and services for commercial or religious activities
2. Sharing login or authentication information (login ID, password, matrix, etc.) with third parties
3. Connecting devices with security issues (such as unsupported operating systems, lack of virus protection, or outdated software) to the Institute's information infrastructure
4. Any actions that impede the efficient operation of information systems within or outside the Institute, such as those that impose an excessive load
5. Any actions that infringe on the confidentiality of communications, including potential acts
6. Using peer-to-peer (P2P) software or other equivalent communication software
7. Infringing copyrights, including the unauthorized use of software
8. Acts that constitute discrimination, defamation, insult, or harassment (including potential acts)
